LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, INDIANA AMENDING CHAPTER 3, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 3-1 AND SECTION 3-2 OF THE HUDSON TOWN CODE RELATING TO THE ABOLITION OF PRECINCTS AND LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS IN THE TOWN OF HUDSON

Comes now the Town Council of the Town of Hudson, and amends the Hudson Town Code by Ordinance for the purpose of continuing the practice of local elections without legislative districts within the Town of Hudson.

Whereas, I.C. 36-5-2-4.1 (e) provides that towns in the State of Indiana having a population of less than three thousand five hundred (3,500) may by ordinance abolish legislative districts and provide that the legislative body be elected at large, and

Whereas, it has been proven difficult to recruit people willing to run for the office of Town Board when the Town is divided into legislative districts, and it would be in the best interest of said Town and its efficient administration that such districts be abolished;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Chapter 3, Articles 1, Sections 3-1 and 3-2 are continued in effect.

Section II. All prior Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
