

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, INDIANA, ESTABLISHING FEES FOR VARIOUS POLICE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson, pursuant to Indiana State Statute, has the authority to establish fees for services of the agencies and activities of the Town of Hudson and;

WHEREAS, the State of Indiana has established revised fees for crash reports, handgun permits, and various other services

WHEREAS, the actual cost of providing these services has increased over the years since the fees were originally established, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Hudson thereby deems it necessary to modify the fees for services rendered by the Hudson Marshal's office, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL, TOWN OF HUDSON, STEUBEN COUNTY, INDIANA, that fees for services provided by the Hudson Marshal, his deputies, or others acting in his behalf, shall be as follows:

1. The fee for a crash report shall be \$ 12.00 per report. If there are photographs of the crash, each copy of a photograph shall be charged at the rate of \$ 1.00 each
2. The fee for an incident (Police) report shall be \$ 12.00 per report. If there are investigative photographs, each copy of a photograph shall be charged at the rate of \$ 1.00 each
3. The town portion of the fees collected by the Hudson Marshal shall be as provided in the table below.

License Type	Town Fee
4 Year Hunting/Target	\$ 10
4 Year Personal Protection	\$ 10
Lifetime Hunting/Target, No current license	\$ 50
Lifetime Hunting/Target, Current valid license	\$ 40
Lifetime Personal Protection, No current license	\$ 50
Lifetime Personal Protection, Current valid license	\$ 40

All fees collected for these services shall be placed in the Law Enforcement Continuing Education fund of the Town of Hudson.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and any legal publication necessary.
