

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON,
INDIANA, ESTABLISHING A REVISED MAXIMUM SPEED ON
RAILROAD STREET.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson, pursuant to Indiana State Statute, has the authority to set speed limits on public streets within the Town of Hudson and;

Whereas, the setting of speed limits on public roads and streets are in the public interest and safety of the citizens of the Town of Hudson, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council has directed the Marshal to conduct a speed survey of Railroad Street and the Marshal reported that the average speed was 22.46 miles per hour, and;

Whereas, the Town Council deems it necessary to modify speed limits heretofore set on certain streets in the Town of Hudson, and;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL TOWN OF HUDSON, STEUBEN COUNTY, INDIANA, that the maximum speed limit on Railroad street for its entire length will be increased from 20 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the violator to the fines and court costs associated with speeding violations as established by the Fremont Town Court.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that after passage of this Ordinance and any publication required by law, the Town shall erect speed limit signs designating the speed as set forth above.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and any legal publication necessary.
