

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON,
INDIANA, ESTABLISHING PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR WATER,
WASTE WATER, AND GARBAGE COLLECTION.**

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson, pursuant to Indiana State Statute, has established water, waste water, and garbage collection services, and;

WHEREAS, water, waste water, and garbage collection services are billed to the customers of these services within the Town of Hudson, and;

WHEREAS, the collection of these fees for property which has been abandoned or for which the billed customer cannot otherwise be contacted represents a burden on the proper accounting and just settlement of water, waste water, and garbage collection account;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL TOWN OF HUDSON, STEUBEN COUNTY, INDIANA, that all charges against a property must be taken care of before service can be resumed at that property

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all rental property charges are ultimately the property owner's responsibility.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that moving from one location to another in no way absolves the customer from any unpaid charges incurred at a previous location. A customer's service may be discontinued at any location for failure to pay any unpaid charges due, regardless of the premises with respect to which the charges were incurred.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Town Council and any legal publication necessary.
